His research focuses on the revitalisation of Ladino by digital means. He is the co-founder and CEO of Ladino 21 Community Interest Company, a public outreach initiative and digital archive devoted to grassroots documentation of Ladino. He is the author of the recent journal article 'The Digital (De)territorialization of Ladino in the 21st century' (*Word: Journal of the International Linguistic Association*, 2021). This academic year he is teaching Ladino at the Oxford School of Rare Jewish Languages, and will be a visiting fellow at CRASSH, Cambridge in Easter Term 2022.
